FORMER Yes Bank top guy Rajat Monga has reason to beam: his 16-year-old son Rohan has just received a National Humanitarian Excellence Award for Dear Me, a platform designed to help caregivers stay sane while tending to ailing loved ones. "My hope is that this will evolve into a global caregiver support system," says Rohan of the initiative, which fuses research, technology and empathy. Proud dad Rajat explains, "Rohan watched his mum support her parents through Parkinson's and a stroke and tapped into that to create something humane and entirely his own." It's a rare mix of pedigree and purpose — the teen has folded his father's love of data into his mother's world of medicine (she's a radiologist at a prominent hospital), turning compassion, algorithms and grit into the city's kindest new calling card.
